The National Corvette Museum has announced the following inductees to be recognized as part of the 16th Annual Corvette Hall of Fame Ceremony in 2013: Wil Cooksey in the category of GM/Chevrolet; Werner Meier in the category of Corvette enthusiast/historian; and Johnny O'Connell, in the category of racing will all be recognized with the highest honor bestowed by the Museum for their contributions to the past, present and future of Corvette.



The 2013 Hall of Fame recipients will be inducted into the Corvette Hall of Fame during a ceremony and banquet on Thursday, August 29, 2013. Their induction will take place as part of the Museum's 19th Anniversary Corvette Celebration festivities August 29-31, 2013.

Two NCM Events this March in Florida

Kicking off the event season is the [Museum in Motion Collector's Tour](#) March 25-28. Starting in Naples, Florida, the participants will be treated to unique and interesting experiences as they travel northward along the Gulf Coast. Starting with a visit to the very private, limited access Collier Collection, the tour will include stops at Muscle Car City, The Ringling Museum, St Armand's Circle in Sarasota and the Fantasy of Flight Museum. Time has been allowed for private exploration and sightseeing as well. Participants can head over to Sebring at the end of the Tour if they want to experience the track world or just be spectators.



The **NCM HPDE** schools have become known for offering more than the routine driving schools. They are attended by many GM engineers and designers giving participants first hand contact with people like Kirk Bennion, designer; Harlan Charles, program manager; Tom Wallace, ret. Chief Engineer; Art Spong, customer quality; and Gerry Panetta, styling studio. Imagine not only being able to meet and talk to these people but also to have them teach you how to handle your car on the track.

If that isn't enough to whet your appetite, consider that special guest instructors who have come to NCM HPDEs include, Andy Pilgrim, John Heinrichy and Shields Bergstrom. They will pilot your car around the track and give you a race type ride and an advanced education.

For the first time ever we will be offering a spectrum of activities at [Sebring March 29-30](#) including an NCCC sanctioned autocross and an All-GM judged car show. Any participant is welcome to the autocross, whether to just try it out, compete for points or times or get rides. Spectators are welcome at all activities including the HPDE and they can sign up for rides on the track or at the autocross as well.

2014 Chevrolet Corvette

Return of the Stingray

Chevrolet is redefining modern performance with today's debut of the all-new Corvette Stingray. And only a Corvette with the perfect balance of technology, design and performance can wear the iconic Stingray designation.

The 2014 Corvette Stingray is the most powerful standard model ever, with an estimated 450 horsepower (335 kW) and 450 lb.-ft. of torque (610 Nm). It is also the most capable standard model ever, able to accelerate from 0-60 in less than four seconds and achieve more than 1g in cornering grip. It is expected to be the most fuel-efficient Corvette, exceeding the EPA-estimated 26 mpg of the current model.

The all-new Corvette Stingray shares only two parts with the previous generation Corvette. It incorporates an all-new frame structure and chassis, a new power train and supporting technologies, as well as completely new exterior and interior designs.



Highlights include:

- An interior that includes real carbon fiber, aluminum and hand-wrapped leather materials, two new seat choices – each featuring a lightweight magnesium frame for exceptional support – and dual eight-inch configurable driver/infotainment screens
- Advanced driver technologies, including a five-position Drive Mode Selector that tailors 12 vehicle attributes to fit the driver’s environment and a new seven-speed manual transmission with Active Rev Matching that anticipates gear selections and matches engine speed for perfect shifts every time
- An all-new 6.2L LT1 V-8 engine combines advanced technologies, including direct injection, Active Fuel Management, continuously variable valve timing and an advanced combustion system that delivers more power while using less fuel
- Lightweight materials, including a carbon fiber hood and removable roof panel; composite fenders, doors and rear quarter panels; carbon-nano composite underbody panels and a new aluminum frame help shift weight rearward for an optimal 50/50 weight balance that supports a world-class power-to-weight ratio
- A sculptured exterior features advanced high-intensity discharge and light-emitting diode lighting and racing-proven aerodynamics that balance low drag for efficiency and performance elements for improved stability and track capability

The new Corvette Stingray will be built at GM’s Bowling Green, KY, assembly plant, which underwent a \$131-million upgrade, including approximately \$52 million for a new body shop to manufacture the aluminum frame in-house for the first time.

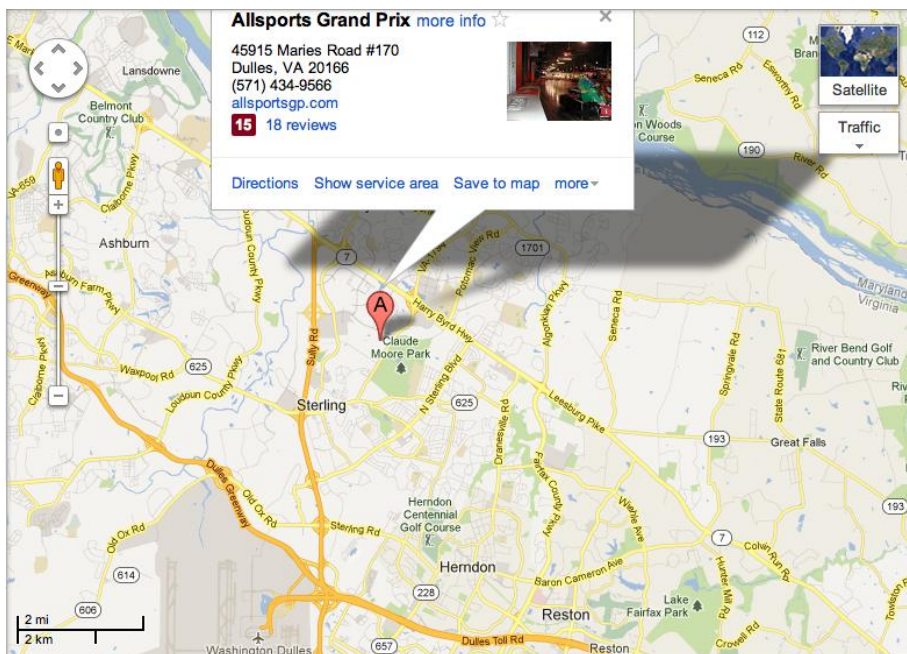

Single License Plate Bill *by Laurie Kistner*

There's pending legislation sitting with the Committee on Transportation suggestion that Virginia move back to only having one plate on each vehicle. Not only will this remove the ugly front plate from our vehicles, it will save ten of millions of waste over the next decade alone.

The legislation is: SB 771 License plates; display of a single plate on registered vehicles.

URGENT LEGISLATIVE ALERT: THE CAR HOBBY NEEDS YOUR HELP

Bill to Provide for Single License Plate Introduced in Virginia Legislature

Virginia legislation (S.B. 771) pre-filed in the legislature for 2013 proposes to reduce the number of license plates furnished by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to registered motor vehicles. Under the bill, favored by state hobbyists, the DMV would issue only one license plate (rather than two) and require the single plate to be attached to the rear of the vehicle.

We Urge You to Contact Members of the Senate Transportation Committee Immediately to Request Support for S.B. 771. S.B. 771 would apply to every registered motor vehicle, semitrailer or trailer, including hobby cars such as antique, reconstructed and replica vehicles. S.B. 771 would protect the aesthetic contours of collector cars and relieve vehicle owners of the burden of having to create mounting holes on fabricated bumpers, etc.
